## SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (SSS) FOR THE STUDENTS OF IIS MAJMA'AH

Dear Parents,

Greetings from IIS Majma'ah!

School Scholarship Scheme (SSS) has been instituted in International Indian School, Majma'ah to support parents economically.

## The scheme is applicable for students in Class VI to Class X.

The application forms for the SSS is available at the school reception. It can also be downloaded from the school website.

Following criteria shall be applied for the consideration of SSS to a student:

- 1. The scheme applies to Indian citizens only.
- 2. It is not an open scholarship. It is expected that only needy parents should apply for consideration.
- 3. Parents should have applied for the grant of SSS on the designated form and fulfilled the economic criteria and verifications.
- 4. Of the applicants, parents receiving the lowest aggregate salary (together for the father and mother), will be considered as the benchmark, and applications will be accordingly incrementally considered. SSS will be considered for student numbers not exceeding 2% in a specific class.
- 5. Applicant children should have been studying in the IISM for at least two years before seeking first consideration. Cases not considered during the first year may be reconsidered for the next year.
- 6. The consideration will be held once in the academic year unless reviewed.
- 7. SSS will be applied to only one child from a family.

8. SSS will be granted for a maximum of two successive years and reviewed thereafter. There has to be a period of two years before the parent can reapply for consideration under the scheme.

9. The only consideration for the grant of SSS will be the economic conditions of the parents and no other criteria such as academic performance, sports achievements, extracurricular activities or miscellaneous aspects will be applied for considerations.

10. The last date to submit the application form given below is on or before 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2024.

Parents are required to furnish written documents for their collective proof of income (husband and wife), duly attested from their employers and General Organization for Social Insurance certificate (GOSI) reflecting their salary. In the absence of either of the two, the application will not be considered.

Based on final approvals the SSS will be granted at the scale of 50% of the aggregate monthly fee.
